Saturday Children's Programs

JULY 5—Kidney Pond—**Katahdin Geographic Explorer**—at this children's program will learn how to navigate with a compass and learn how to read a Topographic map by helping build a simple 3-D model.

JULY 12—Daicey Pond—**DROPPINGS, DROPPINGS EVERYWHERE**—Come and learn how to identify animal droppings, aka Scat. You will receive your very own Scat ID handout and you'll also learn more about the habitat and diet of the animals in Baxter State Park!

JULY 19—Kidney Pond—**Animal Tracks**-All young campers are invited to discover about the animals in the park and will leave able to identify the tracks these critters leave behind.

JULY 26—South Branch Pond—**POND DETECTIVES**—Time to explore the pond and see how many creatures you can find! Come and become a Baxter State Park pond detective.

AUGUST 2—Daicey Pond—*The Web of Life*—Come and learn about the food web that connects the small ant to the big coyote.
